# The Orinda Community Foundation Work Done during 2022

We are happy to announce that the Orinda Community Foundation (OCF) granted over \$70,000 in 2022 to a large number of local non-profit organizations. This total is a 50% increase over 2021's grants. The recipient organizations are multi-faceted in that they help many different people and accomplish many different things. Their overall impact has greatly strengthened engagement and enhanced community spirit in our area!

Our 2022 funds were provided to 25 grantees to support the following organizations and events: The Fourth of July Celebration, Lamorinda Idol, Art in Public Places, Park and Rec Concerts and Movies at the Park, Seniors Around Town,



many more.

OCF is 100% volunteer and locally managed. Since our goal is to be good stewards of the funds entrusted to us, we take pride in being efficient. In 2022, our total administrative and fundraising expenses (mainly the cost of printing and mailing our annual newsletter) were only 6% of the total revenue. By comparison, Charity Navigator gives its highest ranking to organizations that spend less than 15% of expenses on overhead. OCF easily exceeds this standard. In addition, with our governance via a local board with regular meetings, transparent financial reporting, and a division of duties, OCF has been and continues to be a reliable partner to both donors and grant recipients in our community.

# Independent Review Confirms OCF as a Trustworthy Local Charity

How do you know that the non-profit charity requesting support is worth your time and donations? It has been said that people don't give money to charity; they give money to people. Thus, trust in the people requesting donations and in the work of the charity itself is critical. Notwithstanding personal relationships and the programs that are the work of any non-profit, there are several financial fundamentals that any charity should meet. The Orinda Community Foundation has embraced these requirements.

We have been independently reviewed internally and externally. Our accounting and financial processes are sound. Policies and processes that ensure this include:

1) Regular meetings over many years. The OCF Board meets about ten times each year. The Foundation has been a reliable charitable partner to the Orinda community since 2010.

2) Ongoing financial reports. These are presented at every meeting and reviewed by the Board. Any overlaps and/or anomalies arising out of the numbers are questioned. We focus on being efficient careful with expenses but generous with donations.

3) Division of duties. In a small foundation such as OCF, the division of duties is important. There is no staff. Thus, board members share the workload. This has the additional benefit of improved financial controls due to multiple layers of
