

2020 was a year apart from all others! As a society, we suffered losses that none of us, in our lifetime, has previously experienced. The Orinda Community Foundation (OCF) lost two founders in the last year – Carol Penskar, and most recently, Dick Burkhalter. They, in so many ways, made a deep and permanent positive mark on the community we call home.

Aside from Carol's years of dedication to the OCF Board of Trustees and superb work as OCF treasurer from its inception, she volunteered her keen wit and sharp eye to many local organizations including the City Finance Advisory Committee and numerous other causes that benefitted every reader of this article. Carol was in many ways an unsung hero. We at OCF want to publicly acknowledge her many accomplishments and our sense of loss of her talents that we feel every day.

Dick Burkhalter lived a full life and was, until the end, a volunteer extraordi-

naire. Aside from being an OCF founding board member and recent vice president, he was so much more to our community. In addition to his beloved Orinda Rotary, there was nothing that he wouldn't raise his hand to volunteer for-- from selling hot dogs at community events to still in his 80's driving Orinda's Seniors Around Town to get to appointments, or whatever their needs. In so many ways, he was the essence of what we'd all like to be remembered for. Dick, "Thank You" for your many, many acts of kindness, thoughtfulness and service to our community.

OCF stepped up last spring to provide funds to meet a critical need for Covid testing of those living in senior housing. This was a very important act to protect our vulnerable seniors in a timely way. We also acknowledge and thank the many frontline healthcare workers who helped us all get through a year we never saw coming. Without their endless dedica-

tion and devotion to making a difference, one doesn't even want to think where we might be. OCF was honored to collaborate with other local nonprofits by contributing financially to the recent appreciation lunch for deeply deserving healthcare workers and at the same time support our local restaurants.
